Mackinac Registry 1695-1888 CD

Nearly two centuries of lived faith is recorded on this compact disc containing the baptism, marriage and death records of Ste. Anne's Parish, one of the oldest faith communities in the New World. These remarkable records span the history of a key location on the Great Lakes, as it transitioned from French to British and, finally, to American rule.

Through the kind generosity of the Record Recall Document Scanning Services, these records are now available to anyone who is inspired by the story of generations of faithfulness they represent.
