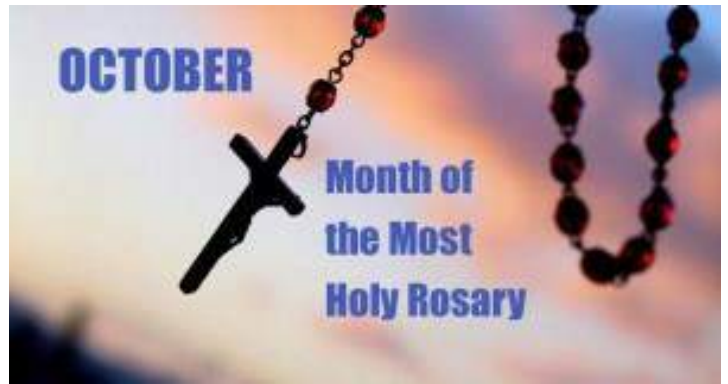

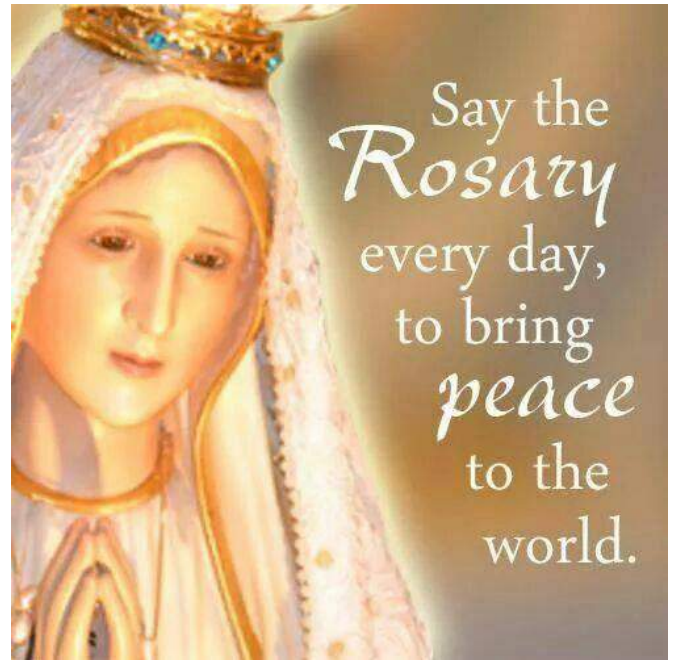
**Quotes from Pope Francis**


