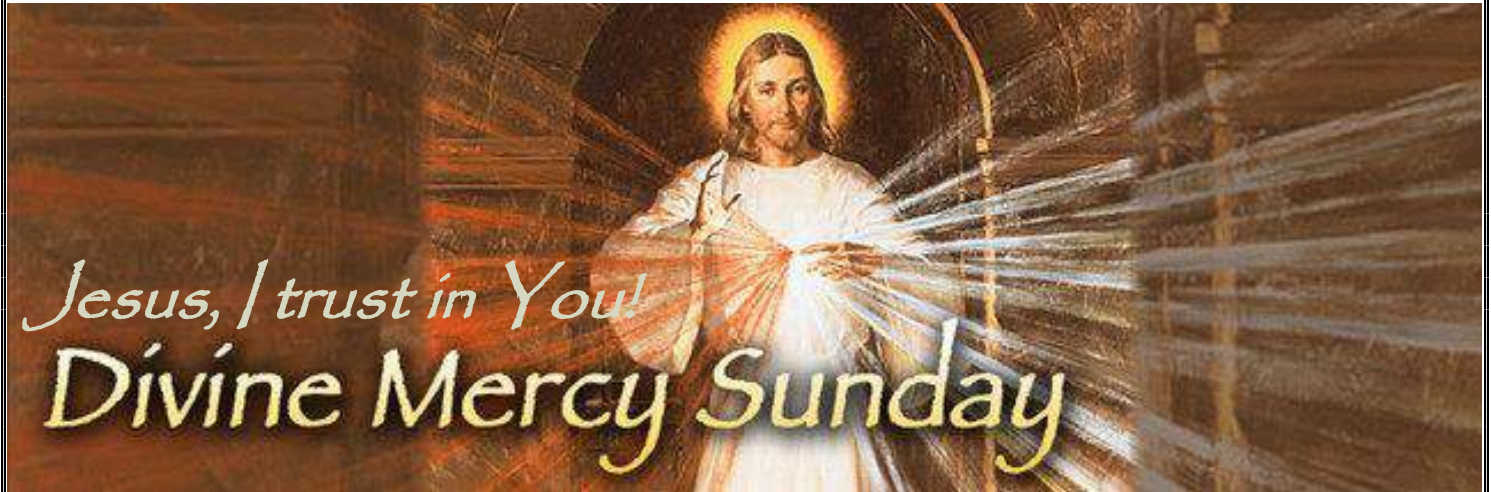

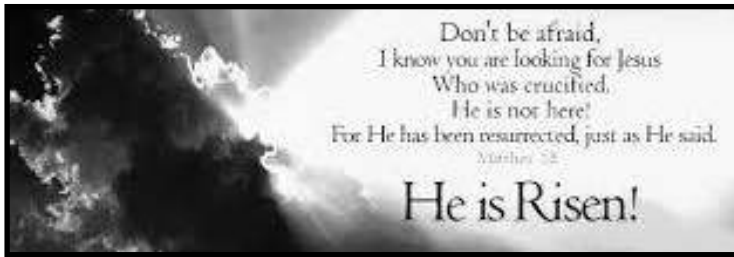


**Jesus, I Trust In You**

Many times we trust a doctor: it is good, because the doctor is there to cure us; we trust in a person: brothers and sisters can help us. It is good to have this human trust among ourselves.

But we forget about trust in the Lord: this is the key to success in life. Trust in the Lord, let us trust in the Lord! "Lord, look at my life: I'm in the dark, I have this struggle, I have this sin...", everything we have: "Look at this: I trust in you!" And this is the risk we must take: to trust in him, and he never disappoints.

**Reflection:** When Jesus appeared to St. Faustina, he gave her a simple phrase to respond to Jesus' mercy. The phrase is: "Jesus, I trust in you." Think of all your current struggles and challenges, then, repeat: "Jesus, I trust in you! Jesus, I trust in you! Jesus, I trust in you!"



### A Prayer for Divine Mercy

O Greatly Merciful God, Infinite Goodness,  
today all mankind calls out from the abyss  
of its misery to Your mercy---to Your compassion,  
O God; and it is with its mighty voice of misery  
that it cries out.

Gracious God, do not reject the prayer  
of this earth's exiles!

O Lord, Goodness beyond our understanding,  
Who are acquainted with our misery through and through,  
and know that by our own power  
we cannot ascend to You,  
we implore You; anticipate us with Your Grace  
and keep on increasing Your mercy in us,  
that we may faithfully do Your holy will  
all through our life and at death's hour.

Let the omnipotence of Your mercy  
shield us from the darts of our salvation's enemies,  
that we may with confidence,  
as Your children, await Your final coming  
- that day known to You alone.

And we expect to obtain everything promised us  
by Jesus in spite of all our wretchedness.

For Jesus is our Hope:  
Through His merciful Heart  
as through an open gate, we pass through to heaven.  
(Diary of St. Faustina 1570)

**The Message of the Divine Mercy that St. Faustina received from the Lord, between 1931 and 1938, was not only directed toward her personal growth in faith but also toward the good of the people.**

Jesus said to St. Faustina:

My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity.

The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the First Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.


