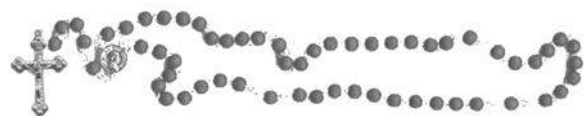
Something New About God




