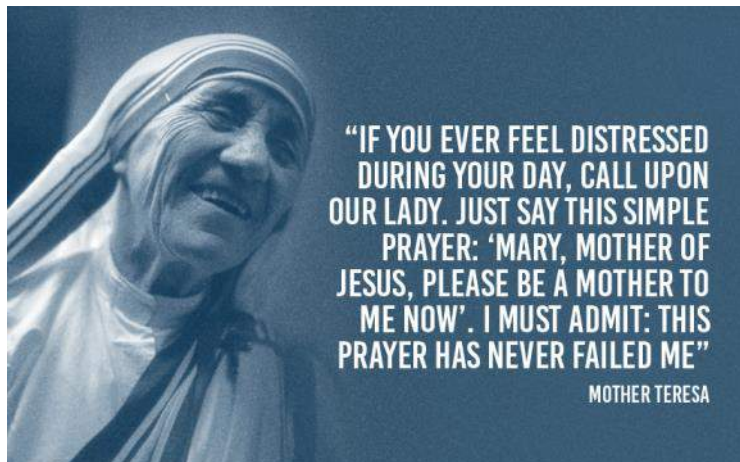

**God's Means of Hearing the Poor**

A mere glance at the Scriptures is enough to make us see how our gracious Father wants to hear the cry of the poor: "I have observed the misery of my people who are in Egypt; I have heard their cry on account of their taskmasters. Indeed, I know their sufferings, and I have come down to deliver them ... so I will send you" (Ex 3:7-10)... If we, who are God's means of hearing the poor, turn deaf ears to this plea, we oppose the Father's will and his plan; that poor person "might cry to the Lord against you, and you would incur guilt" (Dt 15:9). A lack of solidarity toward his or her needs will directly affect our relationship with God.

***Reflection:** How do you live out your relationship with the Father by caring for his sons and daughters? Are you open to hearing the cries of the poor? Do you serve the poor in a consistent way?*




