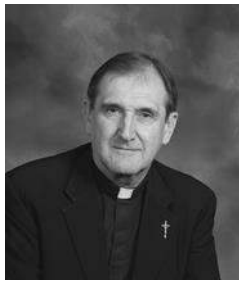
A Prayer for Priests




