Bishop Frederic Baraga's Words of Wisdom

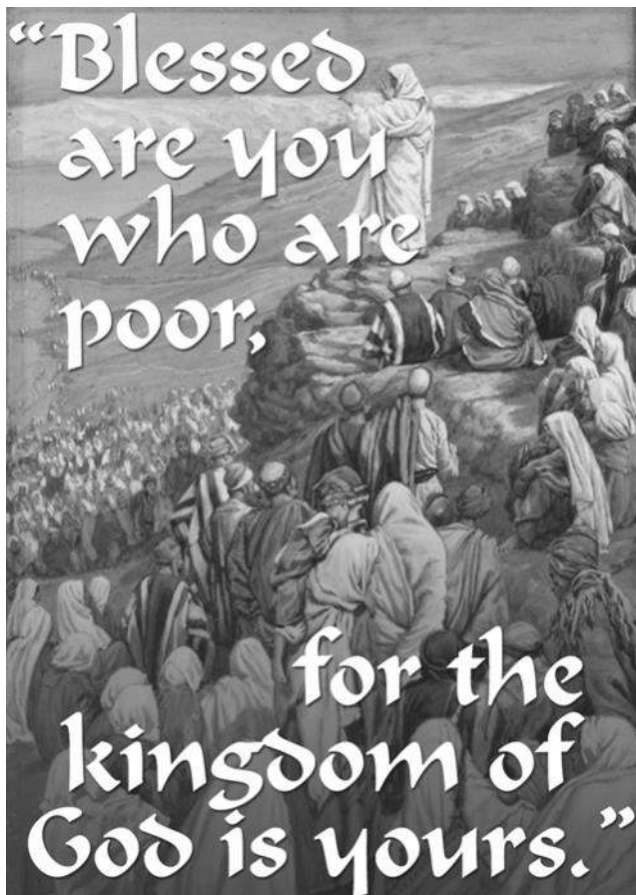

Reflections with Pope Francis Go to Mass Like Sinners



The "Confession" which we make at the beginning [of Mass] is not "pro forma," it is a real act of repentance! I am a sinner and I confess it, this is how the Mass begins! We should never forget that the Last Supper of Jesus took place "on the night he was betrayed" (1 Cor 11:23). In the bread and in the wine which we offer and around which we gather, the gift of Christ's body and blood is renewed every time for the remission of our sins. We must go to Mass humbly, like sinners, and the Lord reconciles us.

Reflection: *The Mass is a deep encounter with the mercy of the Lord. Next time you are there, try to use each element of the Mass to meditate on his mercy. What is he saying to you through the prayers, the readings, and the Eucharist?*




