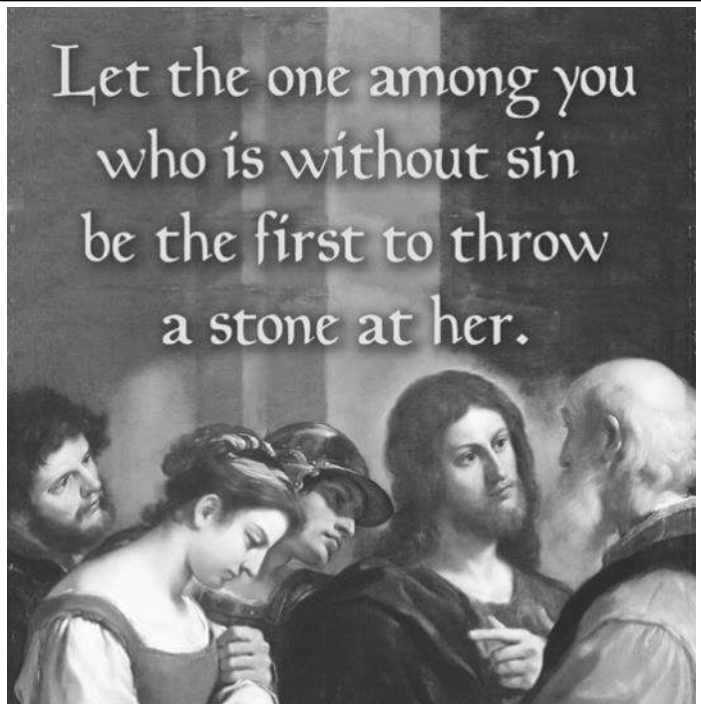

Staying With Jesus



The logic of the Cross...is not primarily that of suffering and death, but rather that of love and the gift of self which brings life.... Following and accompanying Christ, staying with him, demands "coming out of ourselves," requires us to be outgoing; to come out of ourselves, out of a dreary way of living faith which has become a habit, out of the temptations to withdraw into our own plans, which end by shutting out God's creative action.

Reflection: *How are you "accompanying Christ" this week? Ask God to change your logic into the logic of the Cross and to bring you out of a faith that is merely habit.*

Make Time for Praying the Rosary

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops tells us that the summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:

- Mass of the Lord's Supper—Holy Thursday
- Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
- Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord—Easter


