Reflections with Pope Francis

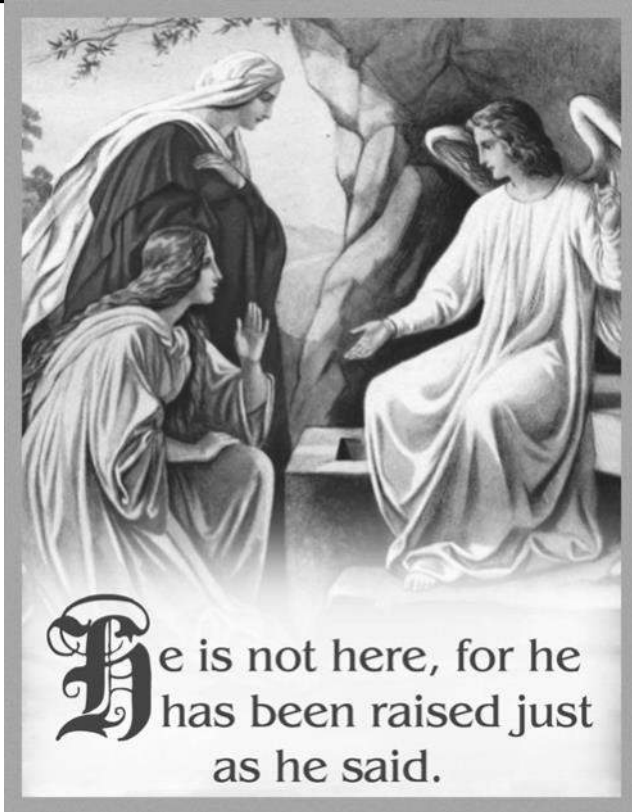
Let Us Feel the Joy!



At dawn, they went to the tomb to anoint Jesus' body and found the first sign: the empty tomb (cf. Mark 16:1). Their meeting with the messenger of God followed. He announced: "Jesus of Nazareth, the Crucified One, has risen, he is not here" (cf. vv. 5-6). The women were motivated by love and were able to accept this announcement with faith: they believed and passed it on straight away; they did not keep it to themselves but passed it on...

This should happen in our lives too. Let us feel the joy of being Christian! We believe in the Risen One who conquered evil and death! Let us have the courage to "come out of ourselves" to take this joy and this light to all the places of our life.

Reflection: Where do you find joy? Ask God to help you make Jesus' new life the center of your joy.

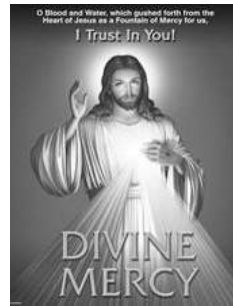


Bishop Frederic Baraga's Words of Wisdom




