## Reflections with Pope Francis

### Numbing Ourselves to Reality



Love today invites us to look beyond the short-term, taking a concern for the generations to come and not leaving them a legacy of easy solutions...It invites us to move forward without numbing ourselves to reality, without being like ostriches burying their heads in the sand in face of failures and mistakes.

Love invites us to accept that in our very weakness is all the potential needed to reconstruct our lives, to be reconciled with each other, and to grow.

**Reflection:** *What failures and mistakes do you need to face? Where is God asking you to grow?*

## 54 Day Rosary Novena August 15 to October 7, 2019

Please join in praying a Novena for Our Nation as an act of reparation, calling upon God through the powerful intercession of Our Lady of the Rosary to heal our country and return it to holiness. The 54 day Novena will take place from August 15 through October 7, with a Rosary Coast to Coast set to take place on October 7.

Traditionally a novena is nine days. This novena makes three novenas of prayers of the Rosary in petition and three novenas of prayer of the Rosary in thanksgiving. The novena consists of five decades of the rosary (one set of mysteries) each day for twenty-seven days in petition, then immediately five decades each day for an additional twenty-seven days in thanksgiving, regardless of whether or not the request has been granted yet.

The first day of the novena always begins with the Joyful Mysteries, the second day, the Sorrowful Mysteries, and on the third day, the Glorious Mysteries. The fourth day begins with the Joyful Mysteries again and continues through the 54 days in that sequence.

**Use this opening prayer to begin the twenty-seven days in petition:** Hail, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, my Mother Mary, hail! At thy feet I humbly kneel to offer thee a Crown of Roses, snow white buds to remind thee of thy joys, each bud recalling to thee a holy mystery, each 10 bound together with my petition for a particular grace. O Holy Queen, dispenser of God's graces, and Mother of all who invoke thee, thou canst not look upon my gift and fail to see its binding. As thou receivest my gift, so wilt thou receive my petition; from thy bounty thou wilt give me the favor I so earnestly and trustingly seek. I despair of nothing that I ask of thee. Show thyself my Mother!

**Use this opening prayer to begin the twenty-seven days in thanksgiving:** Hail, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, my Mother Mary, hail! At thy feet I gratefully kneel to offer thee a Crown of Roses snow white buds to remind thee of thy joys each bud recalling to thee a holy mystery; each ten bound together with my petition for a particular grace. O Holy Queen, Dispenser of God's graces. and Mother of all who invoke thee! thou canst not look upon my gift and fail to see its binding. As thou receivest my gift, so wilt thou receive my thanksgiving; from thy bounty thou hast given me the favor I so earnestly and trustingly sought. I despaired not of what I asked of thee, and thou hast truly shown thyself my Mother.
