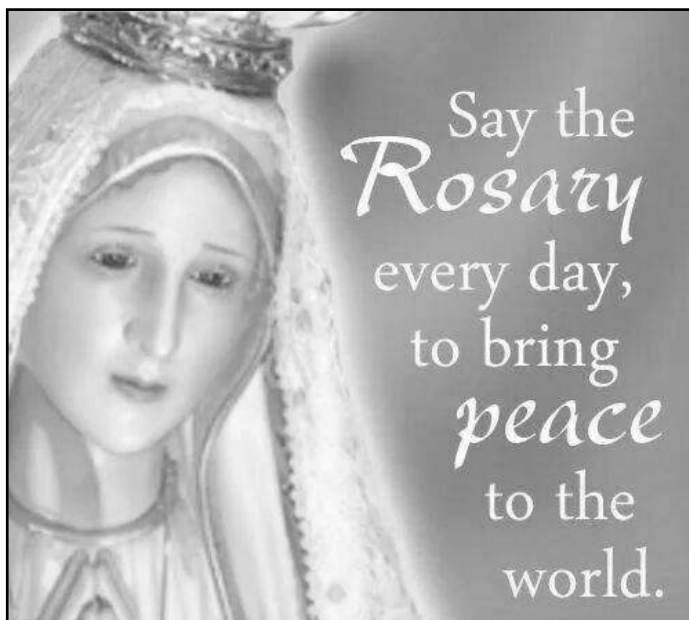
The Feeding America Mobile Pantry will be outside at **Little Bear East Arena**.
