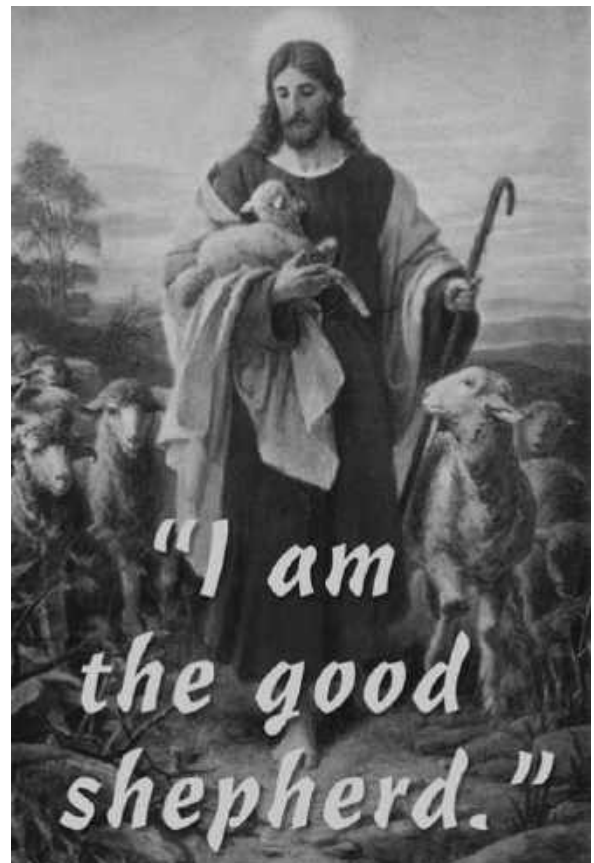

The Evangelist John presents us...with the image of Jesus the Good Shepherd. In contemplating this page of the Gospel, we can understand the kind of relationship that Jesus had with his disciples: a relationship based on tenderness, love, mutual knowledge, and the promise of an immeasurable gift: "I came," Jesus said, "that they may have life, and have it abundantly" (Jn 10:10)....

I invite everyone to place their trust in the Lord who guides us. But he not only guides us: he accompanies us, he walks with us. Let us listen to his Word with minds and hearts opened, to nourish our faith, enlighten our conscience, and follow the teachings of the Gospel.

***Reflection:** What area of your life is not abundant? Jesus promises that committing our lives to his mercy and following his teachings will lead to fulfillment. Pray that God will continue to walk with you in your weaknesses and failings.*
