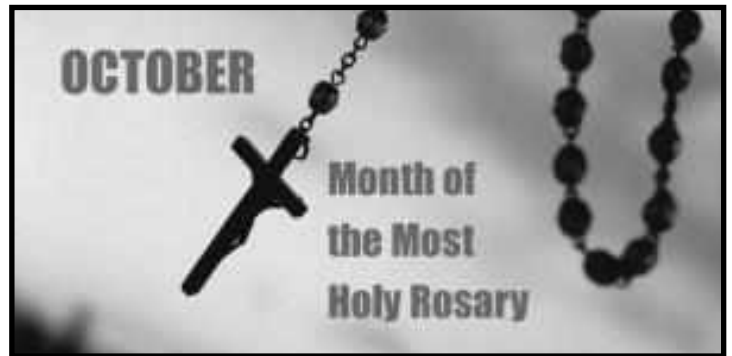
## Reflections with Pope Francis

### **The Breath of Faith Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary October 7**

Prayer is the breath of faith: in a relationship of trust, in a relationship of love, dialogue cannot be left out, and prayer is the dialogue of the soul of God. October is also the month of the Rosary, and on this first Sunday it is a tradition to recite the Prayer of Our Lady of Pompeii, the Blessed Virgin Mary of the Most Holy Rosary.

Let us join spiritually together in this act of trust in our Mother, and let us receive from her hands the crown of the Rosary: The Rosary is a school of prayer, the Rosary is a school of faith!
