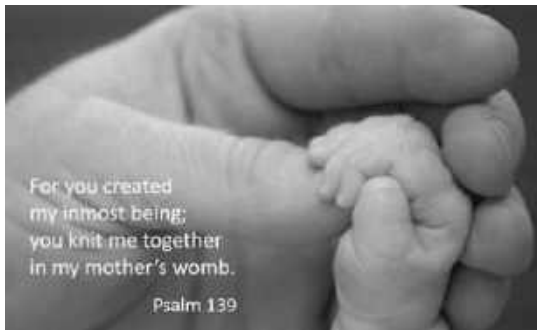

**The Sweetness of Mary**

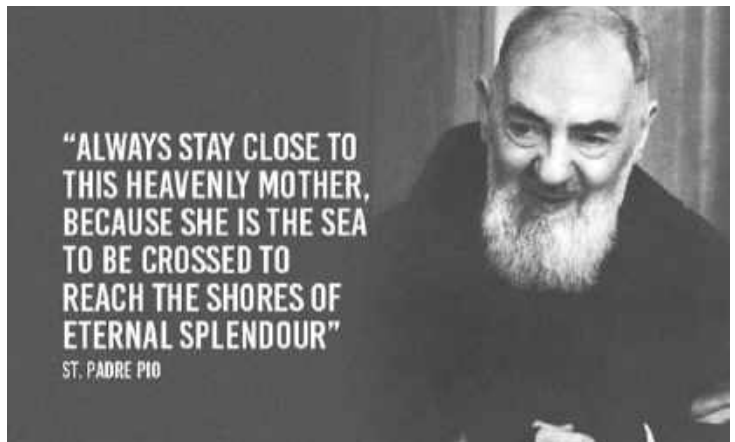
